Insurance

- Optional \$25 covers up to two incidents of loss due to hardware failure, theft, repair, accidental damage
- Full replacement without insurance is \$290.
- Does not cover deliberate or negligent damage to the device
- Does not cover the case, charger or cord
- Removing the protective case from the iPad voids insurance

Internet Filtering

We switched to a new filter this year to address various parent and staff concerns.

- Works consistently at school and home.
- Better ability to monitor social media.
- Easier to manage students who may be having difficulty with the responsibility of a device, such as social media blocking.
- Piloting a parent reporting feature that we hope to see rolled out to everyone this spring.
