Pearson 6th Grade Center Winter Ski Trip

Dear Parents.

For many years Shakopee's sixth grade teachers have taken advantage of the opportunity to provide our students with a day of skiing and fun. We participate in a program offered by the Minnesota Ski Association. We have multiple purposes for our ski trip:

- Provide students an opportunity to try something new. Developmentally this is very
 important for 6th grade age students. They are at an age where they are figuring out what
 they like, who they are, and how to use their free time. When we provide and foster positive
 options for meeting these developmental needs it gives our students the best chance for
 success.
- This is a character and confidence building experience for our students. It gives students a chance, both literally and figuratively, to fall, get back-up and try again.
- Having this experience with team members and staff members helps promote friendships and team bonding. Common experiences help build our team.
- Students are introduced to a new activity in a safe environment. Students who are beginners (most students are) will take ski lessons from certified instructors.

This is a ski trip. For safety reasons snowboards must be left at home. Students are allowed to use their own ski equipment, but the bus company does not allow us to bring skis on the bus. To use personal ski equipment someone would need to transport the equipment to and from Hyland Hills. It is expected that students will dress appropriately for the winter weather including a **coat**, **gloves/mittens** and a **hat/earband**. The warmer students are dressed the more enjoyable their day will be.

<u>Students will need to bring a lunch with them the day of the ski trip</u>. Please indicate on the back of this form if your student will be bringing a home lunch or if they will need a bag lunch from school. Hyland Hills does have food available for purchase in the chalet. They recommend bringing at least \$10 to spend if you plan to have your child purchase food for lunch.

As safe as we try to make this experience, participation in any sport, skiing included, comes with the risk of personal injury and/or damage to property. So, in addition to completing the permission slip below, there is also an agreement and release of liability form from the Three Rivers Park District. By signing the forms, you acknowledge the associated risks of participation and release of liability for the School District & Hyland Hills. You will also need to sign and return the Helmet Rental Agreement which is included in this packet.

The normal cost of a ski rental, lift ticket, and lessons at Hyland would be \$69.00. Our cost is \$18.00 which includes a lift ticket, equipment, ski lessons and busing. Change is not available in the office. Forms are due Friday, December 18th.

HELMET RENTAL RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK **CAUTION: READ BEFORE SIGNING!** THIS DOCUMENT AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS.

EQUIPMENT RENTAL AGREEMENT. Α.

I UNDERSTAND THAT IN ORDER TO FUNCTION AT ITS FULL CAPACITY, THIS HELMET MUST FIT CORRECTLY, AND I AGREE THAT THE PROVIDER HAS SUPPLIED A HELMET THAT PROPERLY FITS ME. I AGREE THAT THE PROVIDER HAS EXPLAINED TO ME THAT THIS HELMET WILL NOT PROTECT ME AGAINST UNAVOIDABLE AND INHERENT RISKS IN RECREATIONAL SNOW SPORTS. When I fasten the chinstrap and shake my head, there is no significant movement of the helmet and at rest it feels comfortably snug. I fully understand all instructions on the correct use and function of the helmet.

In the event of any accident while wearing the helmet or damage otherwise inflicted upon the helmet, I agree to immediately cease use, return it to the rental facility, and provide a written report describing the incident.

I agree to return this helmet to the rental facility by the agreed date in clean condition and understand that I am responsible and will be held accountable for the full retail value of the helmet if I fail to return it. I recognize my responsibility to pay for any repairs if the helmet is damaged beyond normal wear and tear during my rental period.

В. RELEASE OF LIABILITY,

I understand that the sport of skiing and snowboarding ("Recreational Snow Sports") involve inherent risks of INJURY and DEATH. I voluntarily agree to expressly assume all risks of injury or death that may result from Recreational Snow Sports, or which are related in any way to the use of this equipment.

I understand that a helmet designed for Recreational Snow Sports use will help reduce the risk of some types of injuries to the user. I recognize that serious injury or death can result from both low- and high-energy impacts, even when a helmet is worn. I understand that no helmet can protect the user against every foreseeable impact to the head, and that Recreational Snow Sports present unavoidable and inherent risks of injury which surpass the limits of protection offered by this helmet. I understand that this helmet does not protect against trauma to any other part of my body, including my neck, face and spine, and that these limitations are UNAVOIDABLE AND INHERENT RISKS of any activity in which this helmet will be used.

In consideration of the rental of this helmet, I AGREE TO RELEASE, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS Three Rivers Park District, its employees, owners, affiliates, agents, officers, directors (collectively "Providers") from all liability for injury, death, property loss and damage which results from the equipment user's participation in the Recreational Snow Sports for which the equipment is provided, or which is related in any way to the use of this equipment, including all liability which results from the NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR BREACH OF WARRANTY of Providers or any other person or cause.

In accordance with Minnesota law, nothing in this Release should be construed as releasing, discharging, or waiving any claims I might have for other than ordinary negligence.

I agree not to transfer the helmet for use by any other person. (In the event the undersigned does transfer the helmet in violation of this agreement, he/she agrees to indemnify Providers against any claim, demand, losses or damages arising out of the injury or property damage through use of said equipment. This agreement shall be binding and may be pled as a complete bar and defense against any claim, demand, action or causes of action by or on behalf of the undersigned or any user.)

In the event I am signing as a parent or guardian of a minor, I represent I have full authority to do so, realizing this Release of Liability is binding upon the minor as well as myself. As a parent or quardian, I agree to defend and indemnify the Provider for any claims brought by the minor.

This document is a legally binding contract which supersedes any other agreements or representations by or between the parties and which is intended to provide a comprehensive release of liability, but it is not intended to assert any claims or defenses which are prohibited by law. If any part of this agreement is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder shall be given full force and
