ITINERARY

Day 1 Thursday, March 23, 2017 Depart Minneapolis
Depart to Munich on United/Lufthansa Airlines. Fly transatlantic overnight as you enjoy complimentary meals, beverages, and in-flight entertainment.

Day 2 Friday, March 24, 2017 Munich|Český Krumlov
Morning arrival in Munich. Meet your tour guide and depart to the Czech Republic. Make a lunch stop en route. Upon arrival in the UNESCO World Heritage town of Český Krumlov, get settled into your hotel in the town centre. Take time to freshen up and then get out and explore the town. Enjoy a stroll along the Vltava River or visit the State Castle of Český Krumlov. End the day with a traditional Czech welcome dinner.

Day 3 Saturday, March 25, 2017 Český Krumlov|Prague
Enjoy breakfast and then check out of the hotel. Travel to Prague and on arrival have a guided walk in the Old Town. See the Jan Hus Memorial, Tyne Church, Astronomical Clock, Powder Tower and the famous Charles Bridge. Attend the band's first concert in the St. Nicholas Church. Tonight, enjoy dinner in a cozy restaurant such as U Konselu.

Day 4 Sunday, March 26, 2017, Prague
Sightseeing continues today at the Prague Castle high above the city. See the Gothic St. Vitus Cathedral and the nearby Golden Lanes. In the Old Town, walk through the old Jewish Quarter as you make your way back to the Old Town. Take some time for souvenir shopping in the afternoon. Celetna Street is known for its many crystal shops and you will want to spend some time finding the perfect souvenirs. The evening is free to get dinner and enjoy Prague. You may wish to book an evening dinner cruise on the Vltava River.

Day 5 Monday, March 27, 2017 Prague|Vienna
Depart for musical Vienna; capital of Austria. Enjoy a guided sightseeing tour to see the glittering State Opera House, the Imperial Palace, the State Apartments, the National Library and the Hofburg Chapel where the Vienna Boy's Choir sings. Spend the afternoon souvenir shopping on the Stephansplatz. Tonight, travel outside of Vienna to Grinzing and enjoy a Heurigen dinner with local wines at one of many cozy restaurants.

Day 6 Tuesday, March 28, 2017 Vienna
Morning visit to Schonbrunn Palace, the former summer home of the Hapsburg Family that ruled Austria for centuries. Enjoy a free afternoon in the heart of Vienna. Get dinner on your own and then attend the evening concert in St. Stephen's Cathedral by the Shakopee HS Band.

Day 7 Wednesday, March 29, 2017 Vienna|Budapest
Travel the short distance to Budapest. A guided sightseeing tour of the city shows you Parliament, Hero's Square, the Széchenyi Baths and St. Stephen's Basilica. Cross the Danube and drive to the Royal Castle on the Buda side of the river. Here we see the Fishermen's Bastion and the Matthias Church with spectacular views over the city. Spend the evening on the pedestrian-only Váci Street with dinner on your own.

Day 8 Thursday, March 30, 2016 Budapest
You have the entire day to enjoy Budapest. Venture out in small groups and explore the city using public transportation. Visit the Great Market Hall. The unique Széchenyi Thermal Baths are fun if you enjoy swimming and there is excellent souvenir shopping on Andrassy Avenue and on the pedestrian-only Váci Street. Attend the final concert of the tour in the Basilica Esztergom. Following the concert, join the band at Borkatakomba Etterem for a festive farewell dinner.
