The Academies of Shakopee include six career academies within Shakopee High School. Students enter the Freshman Academy to discover their own unique interests. They then choose a home academy for their sophomore through senior year. Each academy has its own physical location inside the high school, a team of teachers, an academy principal, an Academy Champion, and elective courses tied to their academy career pathways.

Exploration is a key component of the Academies of Shakopee. Students, as early as 6th grade, are beginning to explore their interests and plan for their future after high school. Our middle schools are where the beginnings of the academy curriculum shift happened. Elective courses were redesigned and implemented with the goal of students following a course sequence from 6th-12th grade and then graduating from high school with a clear pathway.


After students complete six, quarterlong gateway courses in 6th and 7th grade, they are able to choose electives based on their interests from a specific academy or several academies.



GATEWAY COURSES

Gateway courses are required electives and each are tailored to a specific academy. Students take six, quarter-long gateway courses. Some examples include:

- Think Tank. This is a gateway course for the Business & Entrepreneurship Academy. Students design and create a market a product.
- Teen Engineer. This is a gateway course for the Engineering & Entrepreneurship Academy. Students design and create projects on a 3D printer.
- Snack Attack. This is a gateway course for the Health Science Academy. Students learn about the nutrients of our foods.



MY SABER PLAN

The district is in the process of developing and rolling out My Saber Plan. My Saber Plan is another important tool that will be available for our students (Pre-k through 12th Grade). My Saber Plan is a series of lessons and activities that will help students become more college and/or career ready. At the elementary level, there will be several ways for students to start career exploration from kindergarten through 5th grade. They will also be able to keep track of those interests and skills via My Saber Plan.



Career exploration is already underway in all five of our elementary schools. Our elementary schools develop students for success. Students focus on standards-based framework for learning and individualized, hands-on learning.

They are exposed early to STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering & Math) and encouraged to be critical thinkers. Plans are in the works at the elementary level to implement a full introduction to career exploration.

The goal is to introduce the concepts of the Academies of Shakopee beginning as early as pre-k.


