## **Enroll Today**

We are pleased to offer the following easy 2023/24 Kindergarten enrollment options for children that will be age 5 by September 1, 2023. Translation support is available throughout the process.

Early Childhood Screening is required for students to attend Kindergarten. Children between the ages of three and five are able to get a free evaluation at the district's Pearson Early Learning Center to help better identify development and learning needs including hearing, vision, communication, social and motor skills.

Please note that whether through paper or online registration, you will need proof of your child's age (i.e. birth certificate or passport), immunization records, name of any previous school(s) and special education information (if applicable). Once a child is registered, our team will reach out and discuss your submission, important dates and other helpful details. If transportation is requested, the transportation office will contact you with route information. Bus information for the upcoming school year will be sent to homes approximately two weeks before school starts. We can't wait to see your child(ren) soon!
