Please note you will need proof of your child's age (i.e. birth certificate or passport), immunization records, name of any previous school(s) and special education information (if applicable). Once a child is enrolled, our team will reach out and discuss your submission, important dates and other helpful details. If transportation is requested, the transportation office will contact you with route information. Bus information for the upcoming school year will be sent to homes approximately two weeks before school starts.

Families should plan to dropoff and pick-up their child. Additional transportation details will be provided after registration is approved. Transportation may be available to those that live more than 0.5 miles from their school based on demand.
