ENROLL TODAY

Child(ren) who will be age 5 by September 1, 2025 can enroll for Kindergarten. Transportation is available to those that live more than 0.5 miles from their school.

BEFORE/AFTER CARE

Shakopee Public Schools is also proud to partner with the YMCA in providing high quality care to students in Grades K-5, five days a week. Before and after school care is offered onsite at each of the district's five elementary schools from 6:15am through the start of school and then from the end of school until 6:15pm. School release day care and full day care is also offered.
