

# Elementary & Middle School Schedules

All Saber Online class periods will have a minimum of 50% of live (synchronous) direct instruction. Teachers will remain online for the entire period to continue to support students while they work in small groups or individually. Saber Online will follow the Shakopee Public Schools annual calendar.

# Grades K - 5 Saber Online Program

The daily schedule for students will be 9:05am to 3:45pm daily.

Attendance is taken daily and students are expected to attend each session.

#### **Morning meeting**

#### Daily core instruction in the areas of:

- Reading
- Writing
- Math
- · Social Studies, Science and Health (alternating subjects)

#### Daily specialist instruction on a 10-day rotation

Physical Education, Music, Art and Media

Lunch period (30 minutes)

#### Recess & movement breaks (20 minutes)

Limited availability of High Potential services. Band will not be available.

# **Grades 6-8 Saber Online Program**

The daily schedule for Saber Online students in grades 6-8 will mirror the in-person daily schedule at Shakopee middle schools and is a seven period day from 7:45am to 2:25pm.

Attendance is taken daily and students are expected to attend each period

# Class periods

- · Core classes: English, Math, Social Studies and Science
- Assigned electives: Physical Education, Health, Family and Consumer Science, Art, Technology and Music

#### Lunch (30 minutes)

Accelerated courses limited to math only. Band/Choir and World Languages will not be available.





# **High School Schedules**

There are two ways that an online course may be delivered by a Shakopee teacher.

#### **Full Online Section**

Students will meet daily for "live" instruction with their teacher and other online students during their assigned block.

### **Individualized Approach**

Students will participate in a more self-directed digital curriculum. This will involve daily "live" support from a teacher during their assigned block to monitor progress, either in small group or individual settings.

# **Grades 9-12 Saber Online Programs**

#### **Full-Time Program**

The daily schedule will be a four period block from 8:20am to 3:00pm.
Attendance is taken daily and students are expected to attend each block.

# Class periods (86 minutes each)

- Required classes (Minnesota): English, Math, Social Studies, Science, Health, Physical Education and Fine Arts
- Required classes (District): Financial Literacy, Freshman Seminar and Program of Study sequence (\*credits based on Graduation Class requirements)
- Elective options: Limited course options from the six Career Academies at Shakopee High School: Arts & Communication, Business & Entrepreneurship, Engineering & Manufacturing, Health Sciences, Human Services and Science & Technology as well as World Language

Lunch (30 minutes)

#### **Part-Time Online Program**

Students may opt to take course(s) online as well as "in-person" courses to complete their daily schedule. The daily schedule is in a four-block structure from 8:20am to 3:00pm.

Attendance is taken daily and students are expected to attend each block.

#### Class periods (86 minutes each)

- Required classes (Minnesota): English, Math, Social Studies, Science, Health, Physical Education and Fine Arts
- Required classes (District): Financial Literacy, Freshman Seminar and Program of Study sequence (\*credits based on Graduation Class requirements)
- Elective options: Limited course options from the six Career Academies at Shakopee High School: Arts & Communication, Business & Entrepreneurship, Engineering & Manufacturing, Health Sciences, Human Services and Science & Technology as well as World Language
