

SHAKOPEE COMMUNITY EDUCATION DRIVER'S EDUCATION 2022/23 PROGRAM



Shakopee Community Education provides classroom and behind-the-wheel driver's education instruction for students ages 14.5 and older. Students who attend Shakopee Public Schools or live in the school district will receive priority status when registering.

STATE LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

- Complete 30 hours of classroom instruction
- Pass the state permit test
- Complete 6 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction
- Pass the vehicle road test with the State of Minnesota
 - o Drivers under age 18 are required to submit a driving log showing a minimum of 50 hours of supervised driving experience (least 15 hours must be at night). Parent/guardians are encouraged to provide as many additional hours with their teens as possible to prepare them to become a safe driver.

CLASSROOM & BEHIND-THE-WHEEL PROGRAM COSTS

\$410 fee includes the cost for both the classroom and behindthe-wheel instruction.

• A \$100 down-payment option is available. If you choose this option, the balance is due at the District Office before the last day of classroom instruction. This option is not available online. Please make checks payable to **Shakopee Community Education.**

*Do not make any payments to classroom instructors.

2022/23 CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION

CLASSROOM LOCATION

School-year and summer classroom instruction takes place at Shakopee High School, located at 100 17th Avenue West, in the 2nd floor Lecture Room. Please use the main entrance.

ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES

Students **must** attend 30 hours of classroom instruction to meet state guidelines. Attendance is mandatory. If two or more sessions are missed, they will be unenrolled from the current session and may enroll in a future class, subject to availability and a \$50 change fee.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If you are unable to commit to the full session and would like to cancel your registration, there is a \$50 cancellation fee.

If you would like to be moved to a different session after a session has started, there is a \$50 transfer fee.

WHAT TO BRING

Students should bring a pen or pencil and laptop to class. Students must make their own transportation arrangements.

2022/23 CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION

GETTING STARTED

Once students have completed their 30 hours of classroom instruction, received their permit, and have completed 20 hours of behind the wheel with a parent/guardian—please call the District Office at 952.496.5029 to have an instructor contact you to schedule behind-thewheel lessons.

RESCHEDULING

the-wheel lesson, students must notify their assigned instructor 24 hours before the lessons. Last minute cancellations will be charged \$50 per lesson missed. This amount can be paid at the District Office. The white completion card for behind-the-wheel will be given only after full payment is made.

STUDENT PICKUP

District students will be picked up and dropped off at their home for behind-the-wheel instruction. There is no transportation available for students who live outside of the school district borders.

Students will need to arrange to meet their instructor in Shakopee.

POINT OF IMPACT MEETINGS

The more you know about teen risks, laws and helpful ways to talk with your teen, the more you can help your student become a safe driver. Parents and students are invited and encouraged to attend a 90-minute Point of Impact (POI) class to learn how to improve your own driving instruction and help your teen to become a good driver. We will provide information and tools you can use to help support your teen driving safely.

New drivers have to log 50 hours of driving while they have their permit. Find out how to do this and reduce the required amount by 10 hours by attending a Shakopee Community Education Point of Impact (POI) meeting. Parent/guardians are encouraged to provide as many additional hours with their teens as possible to prepare them to become a safe driver. The driving log must be presented at the time of the road test and submitted with the application for the provisional license.

Parents/guardians and teens are encouraged to attend this class together.

Point of Impact Meeting are held free of charge, but registration is encouraged. Please register at shakopee.k12.mn.us and click the Community Ed tab.

All meetings are held from 8:30-10am at the Shakopee High School, in the 2nd floor Lecture Room.

STATE PERMIT TESTS

ELIGBILITY

Students who have successfully completed 30 classroom hours and assignments, and have enrolled in an approved behind-the-wheel program, will be able to take the state permit test.



SCHEDULING THE TEST

There are two options for taking your state permit test. You can schedule an appointment with the state by going to **drive.mn.gov** and selecting "schedule or reschedule exam."

The other option is registering online with Shakopee Community Education for a \$10 fee. Visit **shakopee.k12.mn.us** and clicking the Community Ed tab or scan the QR code. *Space is limited*.



WHAT TO BRING THE DAY OF THE TEST

If you are taking the state permit test with Shakopee Community Education, please go to **shakopee.k12.mn.us** and click the Community Ed tab.

If you are taking the state permit test at the DMV, go to **dps.mn.gov/divisions/dvs/forms-documents** to find the items needed for the test.

DRIVER'S EDUCATION 2022/23 STUDENT REGISTRATION
