

Stepping Stones Preschool - ONLINE

Stepping Stones Preschool Online provides families with an opportunity to stay connected to Shakopee Public Schools Stepping Stones preschool program in an online “classroom” community. It is designed for families who are not ready to have their preschooler attend in-person but want access to the high quality instruction that our preschool provides our students. We provide an age appropriate learning experience for students and families through our virtual classroom. Families register just as they would for a typical preschool class.

Stepping Stones Preschool Online with feature:

- Instruction provided by a licensed teacher
- Special Education services are available through this model
- Follows the Shakopee Public Schools calendar and is held Monday-Thursday afternoons
- Families can expect to participate in 30-60 minutes of online activities per day
- Every child will participate in 2 live large group and 2 live small group lessons each week
- Daily pre-recorded Circle Time along with additional activities
- Learning packets with materials available for pick-up every month
- Hands on and virtual lessons provided
- Foundational social-emotional skills necessary for school success will be explicitly taught through our Pyramid Model strategies and We Thinkers curriculum. These skills can be practiced at home a variety of ways and parents/guardians will be provided with practical strategies to support their child at home
- Academic curriculums include EZ Write and Zoo Phonics
- Instruction delivered through SeeSaw and Google Meet
- Daily attendance will be taken just as in a regular preschool classroom
- Attendance is determined by daily engagement or direct interaction
- Tuition is \$140 per month
- Pathway Scholarships will apply for eligible families
