





 - Picture Classification







+ Quantitative

 - Number Series








+NonVerbal

Assesses student ability to <u>reason</u> with more novel questions that use spatial and figural content.



Process – Big Picture

- Setup session on teacher computer write the session code on the board
- 2. Students will need headphones
- 3. Students click the Data Manager icon




- 4. Students login using lunch code/ID number and session code session codes expire each night at midnight
- 5. Teacher "approves" students for testing
- 6. Teacher starts and runs the session
 - Teacher stays logged-in as long as class is testing
 - Teacher monitors students as they answer questions
 - Teacher can provide reminders for students to answer questions

Administration

- Test Event created for you
- <u>Test Assignment</u> which test/level students take (created for you)
- Test Session (School Assessment Coordinator creates) consider this like passing out booklets so you will "virtually" pass out 3 different booklets (naming convention building-teacher-topic)
 - Verbal lst (JA-Hartman-Verbal)
 - Quantitative 2nd (JA-Hartman-Quantitative)
 - Non-Verbal 3rd (JA-Hartman-NonVerbal)



- Teacher logs in
- Select Proctoring from the top middle of the screen
- Find and select your test session



Teacher writes Session Code on board



- 1. Students click on "Take a Test"
- 2. A "Confirm App Self-Lock" screen will appear Students click "Yes"
- 3. Students sign in using 6-digit ID and Session Code






- 4. Once students are signed in, their names will appear in the "Waiting for Approval" section of teacher's view
- 5. Students will go to a screen where they can draw pictures






- 6. Once all students show in the list under "Waiting for Approval", teacher clicks on "Approve All"
- 7. All students will be moved to "Approved Students" section
- 8. Students will automatically be moved from the drawing screen to a screen where they will click on "Start My Test"



Troubleshooting

If something doesn't seem to be working properly (student is in a different spot in the assessment than what the teacher screen is displaying, etc.), try clicking on "Refresh Status"
