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





# When Parents Know, Children Grow

Some babies and young children need extra help to learn and grow. While all young children grow and change at their own rate, some children experience delays in their development. Special health conditions may affect children's development, too. Accessing early intervention services as early as possible will ensure the best developmental outcomes for these children.

Help Me Grow: Infant and Toddler Intervention are special services and support for families with children ages birth through two who have developmental delay(s) or certain diagnosed physical or mental conditions or disorders that may result in a delay.

Help Me Grow: Preschool Special Education is for children ages three to five years who meet state eligibility criteria for developmental delay(s) or other disability and who are experiencing challenges in their learning and development.

After a referral is made to Help Me Grow, local school district early intervention or preschool special education staff will contact the family to determine whether a comprehensive screening or evaluation is needed to determine eligibility.

There are three simple steps to refer a child online:

- 1. Visit HelpMeGrowMN.org.
- 2. Click "Refer a Child" button.
- 3. Fill out form and click "Send this Referral."

To refer a child by phone, call 866.693.GROW (4769).

- The PACE (Parent, Adult, Child, Education) Family Literacy Program is
   a unique opportunity that combines:
  - Adult Basic English language learning.
  - Parent education and support.
  - Early Education for children birth through four years of age.
  - Parent and child interaction.

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Transportation may be provided for families who do not have any transportation. *Space is limited.* 

Lunch is provided for children.



# **Stepping Stones Preschool Early Learning Scholarships**

Scholarships are available for families that qualify based on state guidelines. Below you'll find some frequently asked questions about scholarships.

## How do scholarships work?

There are two scholarships that families can apply for, one with funds coming from the state and the other state funds that are issued by our school. Below is a quick breakdown of the two scholarships.

State Scholarship	School Scholarship
Students who qualify will receive \$7500 which can be used for preschool and extended care tuition.	Students who qualify will receive tuition assistance for a 2, 3 or 5 half day preschool program. School scholarships cannot be used toward extended care tuition.
State scholarships are awarded in July on a first-come, first- served basis. Applications can be submitted now.	School scholarships are available immediately on a first- come, first-served basis.

# Who can apply for a scholarship?

To be eligible for an Early Learning scholarship, families must live in Scott County and have a child who is 3 or 4 years old by September 1 of the current school year and not yet eligible for kindergarten. A family must have an annual income at or below the income guidelines in the chart below to apply for a scholarship.

## How do I pay for my class?

All families pay the \$80 non-refundable preschool registration fee at the time of registration. A \$50 initial deposit is due when extended care registration is processed. Monthly payments are due the 1st of each month and can be mailed, sign up for Auto Pay or dropped off at the Shakopee Public Schools District Office located

at 1200 Town Square, Shakopee, MN 55379.

## How do I register?

Choose a class based on your child's age as of September 1, 2019. All preschool registrations must be in-person and include the non-refundable \$80 registration fee. An initial deposit of \$50 is due when extended care registration is processed.

Registrations will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

Please contact our office at 952.496.5054 if you have questions about program registrations.

\*Registration for extended care is required two (2) weeks prior to the students 1st day of enrollment. Payment is due by the 1st of each month. Breakfast for morning care students, snack and lunch for midday care students will be provided through the district's food service. These fees are included in extended care tuition payments.

## How do I pay for my class?
