

We recognize the importance of the early years in a child's development. Right from birth, you shape your child's development and set the stage for future learning and growth. That's why we offer a variety of classes that provide information, encouragement and support for you and your children. After all, you are your child's first and most important teacher.

We are committed to meeting the needs of all families. We offer in-person classes as well as distance learning online classes. Day, evening and Saturday classes are available to fit the schedules of at-home and working parents, grandparents and caregivers. In-person classes meet once a week at the Pearson Early Learning Center and include parent-child play focused developmental learning activities and educator-led discussions. All of our ECFE classes are led by experienced, licensed teachers who create a safe learning environment where children thrive and parents receive information, friendship and support.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT ECFE CLASS OPTIONS DURING THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR

We are definitely living in a time of uncertainty around concerns about our health and COVID-19. Our ECFE mission remains the same – to create and provide quality parenting and early childhood resources and learning opportunities. We continue to offer programming in compliance with State and Federal guidelines during this pandemic. We are thinking of your family's safety at each step along the way. We also understand the need to be flexible with programming and that there will likely be differences in what you see printed here, and perhaps changes in program delivery methods. Please regularly check our Facebook page, facebook.com/district196ecfe, and our website, https://www.shakopee.k12.mn.us/Domain/18 for the most current information.

IN-PERSON CLASSES

- · Parents and children interact and explore activities together for the first part of class.
- Following parent/child interaction time, parents meet together with a licensed parent educator for discussion of topics related to child development and parenting.
- While parents meet for parent discussion, children participate in age-appropriate activities with a licensed early childhood teacher. Children are provided experiences which encourage social, emotional, physical and cognitive development.
- Class is limited to 5 families due to the COVID-19 Safe Plan.
- Families will receive a prorated tuition credit in the event that we would need to stop in-person classes and move to distance learning classes permanently.

IN-PERSON SIBLING CARE

- NEW! Sibling care requires a separate registration with it's own class code.
- Sibling care is offered for siblings of class participants for most in person classes and payment is based on a sliding-fee scale.
- Care is provided for children 6 weeks old through kindergarten. Parents have the option to keep their Infant up to 2 months with them in class. Once a child reaches the age of 2 months the child will need to sign up for sibling care.

ONLINE DISTANCE LEARNING CLASSES

- In the event we need to move to distance learning our methods of instruction will be modified to online virtual classes. Classes meet weekly and consist of one 30-minute parent education/discussion time and one 15 minute circle time and activity for the children.
- Distance learning classes will use SeeSaw and Google Meet platforms.
- Families will receive children's and parent learning materials to be picked up prior to the class starting. Your ECFE teacher will contact you with information about picking up activities and materials.
- A reduced sliding fee for distance learning class will be implemented.

PARENT-ONLY ONLINE CLASSES

- · Parents will connect virtually to discuss parenting topics.
- These are not live virtual classes. You can attend whenever it fits into your schedule.

NEW!!!! To ensure that state identification numbers are correctly assigned to children enrolled in ECFE classes, we ask that you bring a photo-copy of your child's birth certificate to your first class.

- Choose a class based on your child's exact age as of September 1, 2020, unless otherwise specified.
- Classes are designed to be developmentally appropriate. Choosing an incorrect aged class may result in your child not getting into a class and missed opportunities.
- Payment is required at time of registration.

Registrations are first-come, first-served and begin January 11th.

ECFE Cancellation policy

If the class is filled

You will receive a full refund of the class fee.

If the class is canceled

You will receive a full refund of the class fee.

If you cancel your registration

100% of the class fee will be refunded if you cancel one week before the class starts.

75% of the class fee will be refunded if you cancel before the 2nd week of class.

50% of the class fee will be refunded if you cancel before the 4th week of class.

No refund is given after the 4th week of classes.

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When Parents Know, Children Grow

Some babies and young children need extra help to learn and grow. While all young children grow and change at their own rate, some children experience delays in their development. Special health conditions may affect children's development, too. Accessing early intervention services as early as possible will ensure the best developmental outcomes for these children.

Help Me Grow: Infant and Toddler Intervention are special services and support for families with children ages birth through two who have developmental delay(s) or certain diagnosed physical or mental conditions or disorders that may result in a delay.

Help Me Grow: Preschool Special Education is for children ages three to five years who meet state eligibility criteria for developmental delay(s) or other disability and who are experiencing challenges in their learning and development.

After a referral is made to Help Me Grow, local school district early intervention or preschool special education staff will contact the family to determine whether a comprehensive screening or evaluation is needed to determine eligibility.

There are three simple steps to refer a child online:

- 1. Visit HelpMeGrowMN.org.
- 2. Click "Refer a Child" button.
- 3. Fill out form and click "Send this Referral."

What is the Pyramid Model?

The Pyramid Model is a framework for supporting social emotional competence in young children. This model focuses on promoting the social, emotional, and behavioral outcomes of young children birth to five. It reduces the use of inappropriate discipline practices, promotes family engagement, uses data for decision-making, integrates early childhood mental health consultation and fosters inclusion.

Registration for the 2021-22 school year begins on February 1st, 2021 and is open until classes are filled.

Stepping Stones Preschool Early Learning Scholarships

Scholarships are available for families that qualify based on state guidelines. Below you'll find some frequently asked questions about scholarships.

How do scholarships work?

There are two scholarships that families can apply for, one with funds coming from the state and the other using state funds that are issued by our school. Here's a quick breakdown of the two scholarships.

State Scholarship	School Scholarship
Students who qualify will receive \$7500 which can be used for preschool and extended care tuition.	Students who qualify will receive tuition assistance for a 2, 3 or 5 half day preschool program. School scholarships cannot be used toward extended care tuition.
State scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. Applications can be submitted now.	School scholarships are available on a first-come, first-served basis and awarded in July.

Who can apply for a scholarship?


To be eligible for an Early Learning scholarship, families must live in Scott County and have a child who is 3 or 4 years old by September 1 of the current school year and not yet eligible for kindergarten. A family must have an annual income at or below the income guidelines in the chart below to apply for a scholarship.

Please contact 952.496.5861 for specific information on how to apply for an Early Learning scholarships. Families that are over the income guideline but are experiencing a family hardship can contact our main office for scholarship consideration. **Apply early.**
