

# HEALTH & SAFETY RULES & PROCEDURES

Updated 9/28/21

Keep Shakopee students and staff thriving in a safe and consistent environment while being mindful of community spread and necessary health & safety guidance.

Persons with symptoms of COVID-19, or persons infected by COVID-19 must follow health and safety rules and not be present in the school zone.

## DISTRICT-WIDE FACE MASK/COVERING RULES

### TRANSPORTATION



Per Federal order, all persons are required to wear face masks when on school buses/ transportation.

### COMMUNICATION

#### All Schools & Grades:

When a COVID-19 case is confirmed, a notification will be sent to a class or classes within 24 hours of notice.

#### District Website

County COVID-19 case rates will be posted to district website daily Mon-Fri (excluding holidays).

COVID-19 cases by site will be posted every week.

## STUDENTS & STAFF GRADES 7 – 12: FACE MASKS/COVERING RULES

Face mask recommendation/requirement determined by a 14-day rolling average of confirmed COVID-19 cases per 10,000 in Scott County or COVID-19 activity within a school/grade.

### SCENARIO #1



If 14-day County case rate is less than 40 per 10,000 residents



**VACCINE**

Masks Recommended

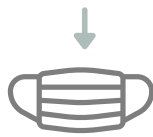
Masks Strongly Recommended

inside school buildings and at large outdoor events with limited social distancing.

### SCENARIO #2



14-day County case rate is greater than or equal to 40 per 10,000 residents for three consecutive days



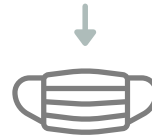
**Masks are Required**

inside school buildings until the cases fall below 30 for five consecutive days.

### SCENARIO #3



If 5% or more of students in a specific site: West Middle School, East Middle School, Shakopee High School, Tokata Learning Center have COVID-19 or COVID-like cases for three consecutive days



**Masks are Required**

in the impacted building/site until the percentage falls below 3% for five consecutive days.

Students & Staff: Early Learners (Ages 3-5) & Grades K-6th see face mask/covering rules on next page



# HEALTH & SAFETY RULES & PROCEDURES

Persons with symptoms of COVID-19, or persons infected by COVID-19 must follow health and safety rules and not be present in the school zone.

## STUDENTS & STAFF: EARLY LEARNERS (AGES 3-5) & GRADES K-6TH

Face mask recommendation/requirement determined by a 14-day rolling average of confirmed COVID-19 cases per 10,000 in Scott County or COVID-19 activity within a school/grade.

### SCENARIO #1

< 20

If 14-day County case rate is less than 20 per 10,000 residents



**VACCINE**

Masks Recommended

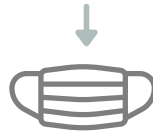
Masks Strongly Recommended

inside school buildings and at large outdoor events with limited social distancing.

### SCENARIO #2

≥ 20

14-day County case rate is greater than or equal to 20 per 10,000 residents



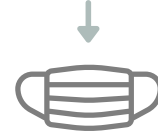
**Masks are Required**

inside school buildings with limited social distancing until the cases fall below 10 for five consecutive days.

### SCENARIO #3

≥ 5%

If 5% or more of students in a specific site (an elementary school, 6th grade E/W, ages 3-5 at Pearson) have COVID-19 or COVID-like symptoms



**Masks are Required**

in the impacted building /grade level will be required to wear a face mask indoors at school until the percent- age falls below 3% for five consecutive days.
