REVIEW SCHOOL PROCEDURES & DIGITAL DEVICE AGREEMENT IN THE ONLINE HANDBOOK

General Reminders:

COMPLETE REQUIRED ENROLLMENT PAPERWORK

Log into Infinite Campus to complete the required enrollment information (QR code above).

1. Complete general & emergency contact info
2. Complete contact preferences (opt-in for text, check email preferences, update main contacts, etc.)
3. Complete/Update household information
4. Complete digital device agreement
5. Complete/Update health information; immunization records can also be emailed or delivered to the school nurse
6. Complete the Educational Meal Benefits form

PARKING PASSES

To receive a parking permit, process the application and payment in our Infinite Campus/Parent Portal/School Store. The fee is \$120 for the year.

Permits will be available for pickup on Schedule Pick-Up Days and Open House. Please show receipt of purchase to pick up the parking pass. Once school starts, parking passes can be picked up in the Main Office.

There are specific times/days allotted for each Academy to help ensure a positive experience. If you cannot make your assigned session, you may attend at another time during the 8:00am - 4:00pm block on either day. School photos will be taken for the yearbook and photo ID at this time.
