We have discovered that our rent will be going up in September. Unless we can come up with a way to save money, we may need to move to a smaller, cheaper building. Moving to a smaller space would mean discontinuing our program for two-year-olds. We know that families do not want these classes to disappear. If you can help us raise extra money, Riggs Preschool can stay where it is. We will be asking for your ideas at the meeting.

We also know that families dislike having to prepay for school. But, if enough people can pay ahead of time this summer, it will help us stay in the space we have. We can also save money by closing our cafeteria. We would serve precooked meals instead. The school may also have to raise its prices for meals. Some families may disagree with this, but it would save us thousands of dollars.

At our special meeting, Dr. Alicia Spar will continue her talks about taking care of young children. She will talk about what to do when kids misbehave. She has lots of ideas about how to get kids to behave well.

For forty years, Riggs Preschool has helped young children prepare for kindergarten. Please come to our special meeting on April 10 to discuss ways we can continue to do this. We look forward to seeing you there!
