## **Open and Closed Syllable Patterns**

An open pattern is a syllable that ends with a vowel. The vowel in an open syllable is usually long.

> V CV cra/ter di/ner le/gal

A closed pattern is a syllable that ends with a consonant. The vowel in a closed syllable is often short.

> VC CV num/ber mag/net den/tist

Not all syllables that divide between two consonants have closed syllables with short sounds.
