

Dividing Words with VCC/CV, VC/CCV, and V/V Patterns

VCC/CV syllable pattern:

divide *after* a consonant blend or a consonant digraph

pump/kin

part/ner

sand/wich

VC/CCV syllable pattern:

divide before a consonant blend or consonant digraph

hun/dred

dol/phin

ex/plain

V/V syllable pattern: divide between the long vowel at the end of a syllable and the vowel at the beginning of the next syllable

po/em i/de/a

sci/ence

Sometimes words with the V/V syllable pattern will have more than two syllables.
