## Unaccented Final Syllables with -le, -el, -il, -al

- The final syllable in words that end in -le, -el, -il, or -al is usually the unaccented syllable.
- The -le, -el, -il, and -al final patterns all have the sound /əl/.
- The -le and -el final endings are the most common; -il is the least common.
- Words with the -al ending are often adjectives or nouns.

## Syllable Patterns:

- VC/Cle: hud/dle
- VC/CV: ton/sil
- V/CVC: la/bel
- VC/VC: trav/el
