Prefixes dis-, mis-, pre-

Prefixes are letters added to the beginning of base words.

Adding a prefix changes the meaning of the base word.

dis- = "not" or "opposite of"	mis- = "wrongly"	pre- = "before"
<u>dis</u> obey	<u>mis</u> lead	<u>pre</u> arrange
<u>dis</u> loyal	<u>mis</u> behave	<u>pre</u> heat
<u>dis</u> taste	<u>mis</u> treat	<u>pre</u> view
