

Spellings for Irregular Plurals

Words ending in the letter f:

Change f to v and add -es

one
$$loaf - f + v + es = two loaves$$

one wolf $-\mathbf{f} + \mathbf{v} + \mathbf{es} = \text{two wolves}$

Words ending in fe:

Change fe to v and add -es

one wife
$$-$$
 fe $+$ v $+$ es $=$ two wives

one knife – fe + v + es = two knives

Some irregular plural words change letters:

one mouse --> two mice

one child --- two children

Some words have the same spelling for singular and plural:

one salmon —> two salmon

one scissors —> two scissors
