3 Main Areas of Expenditure

- Adding completely new programs 45K
- "Elevating" existing programs 45K
- Reserved funds 60K

TOTAL of up to 150K; Referendum approved up to 200K



Reserved Funds - 60K

- 40K for Large Scale music program requires more study and potential curricular adjustments
- Covering more entry fees for HOSA, DECA, etc.
- Supplies for programs without specific anticipated funding

• 10-15 at HS

• 4+ @ each school

Adding staff to large programs

Small stipend for student interest clubs

• Currently 7-10; reserve funds for 10 more (at HS and MS)
