2020 Shakopee Boys Basketball 1st-2nd Grade Spring Programs

2020 Grade 1 Development

Introduction to basketball for boys currently in grade 1. Focus will be on the fundamentals of dribbling, passing, rules of the game, shooting, and rebounding. Baskets will be at 8 feet. Each session will consist of skills stations and informal team play. Individual teams will not be formed.

Grade 2 Boys Basketball is a fundamental program that will concentrate on skills, ball handling, rules of the game and sportsmanship. This is a parent-coached basketball program designed to promote fun while participating in organized practices and games. Teams will be formed. A 27.5 size basketball will be used and the basket height will be 9 feet.

There will be 1 night of evaluations, 5 practices, and 5 games. *Off the week of Spring Break*
