



This is an intricate process that involves teacher teams, specialists, administration, and support staff. Our goal is to provide a safe, secure, supportive environment for every student to optimize learning and provide an exceptional educational experience. Our class makeup goal is to achieve a balance of class size, gender, demographics, unique learners, learning styles, academic strengths and challenges, and English language acquisition. The team also considers potential peer conflicts, delivery of special service scheduling, and any other special circumstances that need attention when constructing classes.

Many traits of our learners are best shared directly with their teacher. Fortunately, we have the opportunity to do that as a part of our Connect and Assess days at the beginning of the school year. Specific educational needs, emotional supports, social goals, and other considerations are examples of qualities that are best discussed with the classroom teacher during Connect and Assess days. A separate communication will be sent closer to school starting to set up this appointment with your assigned 20-21 teacher.

The optional parent/guardian input form is available to parents/guardians who would like to provide input for student grouping considerations. These forms will be shared with teachers both to assist in the class assignment process and to better inform the 20-21 teachers of student needs. We work hard to make sure all Shakopee Public School employees constantly sharpen their talents and work for continuous growth in order to meet the needs of all students through the best education possible. Once class lists are completed, there is a delicate balance in class makeup easily imbalanced by student movement between sections, so any concerns must be considered before classes are set. Once class rosters are completed, it is difficult to change class assignments.

Please remember: this form is optional and is not required for parents who would like teachers to consider student qualities on the form as classrooms are assembled. It will not be used to consider specific teacher requests.




