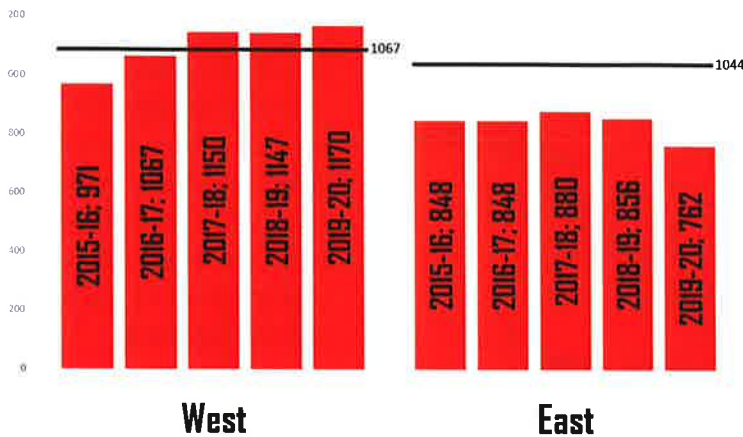

2020-21 MIDDLE SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AREAS

Enrollment by Year vs. Capacity



Growth patterns within the district over the last nine years have led to a growing difference in the number of students at each of our middle schools. West is more than 100 students over capacity while East is about 300 students below capacity.

The difference in size of each school presents some challenges in the way our schools operate including: pressure on common areas, challenges in the teaming structure for teachers, and core staffing.

New attendance areas will balance enrollment at the middle school level. As this process continues, we are committed to maintaining quality education and resources at both East and West.

Beginning in the 2020-21 school year, our district will have new attendance areas for East Middle School and West Middle School.

Current student count difference between East and West Middle Schools.

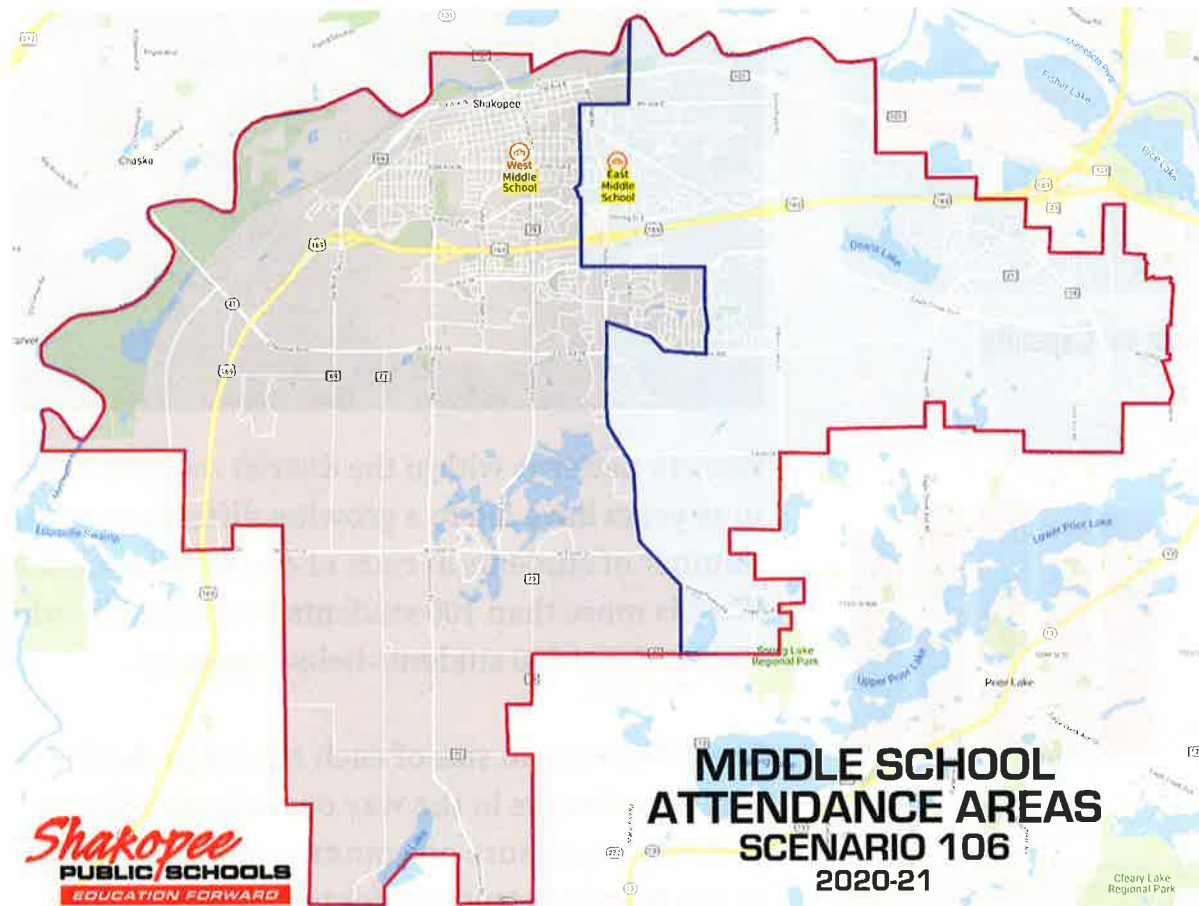

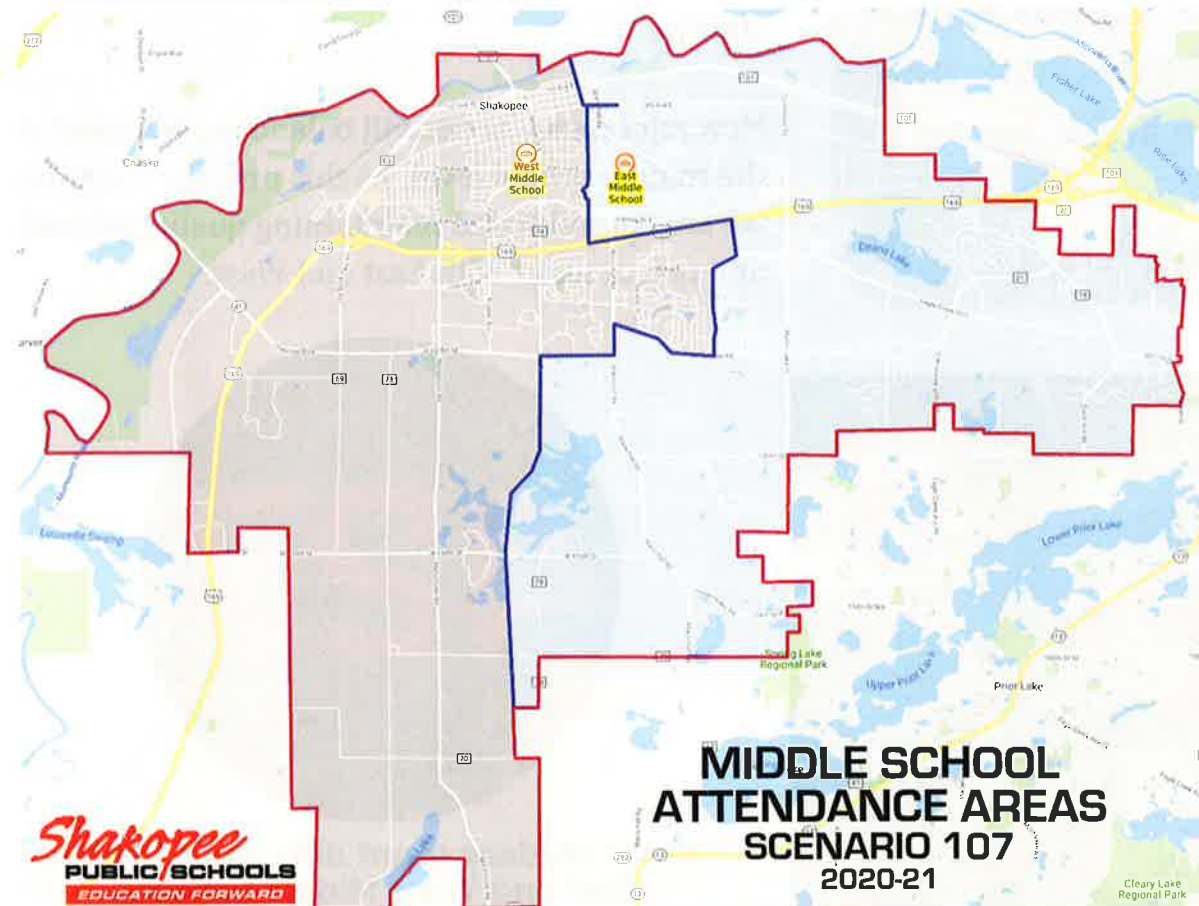
Information & Input Sessions are scheduled at both middle schools:
