

Need Health Care / Health Insurance?

- **Need low cost health care (community clinic info) or assistance** to determine which health care program is for your family? Contact Portico @651-603-5100.
- **Free Mobile Health Clinic for all ages:** go to <http://www.co.scott.mn.us> for the schedule. When the Van is in Shakopee it is parked at the Russian Evangelical Church on 10th Ave and Marschall Road.
- **Free immunizations for children** without insurance at the Public Health Nursing Clinic at 792 Canterbury Road South, Suite A160 on Mondays 1-5.
- **Free nurse consultation about health resources** at the River Valley Nursing Center at 792 Canterbury Road South on Mondays 1-6.
- **Medical Assistance** 952-445-7751 (note income eligibility levels are higher for pregnant women and children under 2)
- **Minnesota Care Insurance** for working families 651-297-3862 (note that you are required to be without insurance for 4 months, apply one month after loss of insurance because the process takes about 4 months)
- Go to www.ehealthinsurance.com to shop for **non-group health insurance plans**.
- Low income / no insurance / need vision care for your child: contact a Licensed School Nurse for resources.
- Questions: contact the Cultural Liaison at your school or a Licensed School Nurse at 952-496-5073, 5075, or 5081.
- **Children's Dental Plan** comes to Shakopee twice a month providing dental care on a sliding fee basis or for children on MN Care or Medical Assistance. Call 612-746-1530 and ask for an appointment at the Shakopee site.
- If your family has experienced a job loss, remember to check if you are now eligible for **free or reduced lunch** at school with a lower family income.
