**Goal 1**

Red Oak Elementary School will increase the percentage of students meeting or exceeding standards in summative math assessments from 75.5% to 80% of students for the 22-23 school year.

*What is our current reality?*

Red Oak Elementary School currently has 75.5% of students meeting or exceeding standards in summative math assessments (21-22 school year)

*What will this look like when we are done?*

Red Oak Elementary School will have 80% of students meeting or exceeding standards in summative math assessments

*How are we going to measure our progress on this goal?*

1. Each teacher that teaches math will implement data collection practices for each student on summative assessments throughout the 22-23 school year.
2. Data will be discussed and analyzed at grade level PLC meetings.
3. Team leads will report summative assessment data to the Principal and will be presented at monthly staff meetings.

Red Oak Elementary School will decrease office managed referrals from 37.9% to 33% with an emphasis on our students of color for the 22-23 school year.

*What is our current reality?*

Red Oak Elementary School had 37.9% of all referrals as office managed for the 21-22 school year.

*What will this look like when we are done?*

Red Oak Elementary School will have 33% or less of referrals as office managed for the 22-23 school year.

## *How are we going to get this done?*

School Year	Action Steps
2022 - 2023	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Utilizing support from other staff in the building<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Any staff can call for support from Crisis team or admin/intervention team</li><li>b. Support with behavior, intervention needs, resources, etc</li><li>c. Both proactively and reactively to a student's behavior and referral data collection</li></ol></li><li>2. Strategic implementation of Development Designs (DD)- ONE focus area for each quarter<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. DD trained staff</li><li>b. DD strategy of their choice</li><li>c. At minimum, once per week.</li></ol></li><li>3. Providing specific feedback often<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. All staff</li><li>b. Specific, meaningful feedback to students, staff and families</li><li>c. Frequently throughout the 22-23 school year.</li></ol></li><li>4. Modeling! Remodeling of routines and expected behaviors<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. All Red Oak staff</li><li>b. Model and remodel for students</li><li>c. Proactively and frequently throughout the 22-23 school year.</li></ol></li><li>5. Increase family involvement (SeeSaw, volunteering, lunch, at-home projects, cultural night)<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Red Oak Staff to Red Oak families</li><li>b. Invite families to engage in a variety of activities at school</li><li>c. For school events and specific classroom events and volunteer opportunities.</li></ol></li></ol>
