Goal 1

East Middle School will increase attendance from 90% of students in attendance 92.0% of the time to 90% of students in attendance 95% of the time.

What is our current reality?

East Middle School currently has 90% of students attending 92.0% of the time as measured by our year total in 2021/2022.

What will this look like when we are done?

East Middle School will have 90% of students attending school 95% of the time by the end of the school year June of 2023. This would be a 3% increase from the previous school year.

How are we going to measure our progress on this goal?

1. Pulling attendance data from Infinite Campus weekly/monthly.
2. Pulling data for behaviors weekly/monthly
3. Pulling grade data weekly/monthly.

What is our current reality?

East Middle School currently has 97.03% of students with passing grades at school year end 2022.

What will this look like when we are done?

East Middle School students will have 98.03% passing grades at the end of school year, June of 2023. This would be a 1% increase from the previous year.

How are we going to measure our progress on this goal?

1. Pulling failure data from Canvas weekly/monthly
2. Pulling failure data from Infinite Campus weekly/monthly
3. Pulling behavior and suspension data from Campus
4. Pulling data for positive behavior award/tickets given monthly.
5. Student grading and support discussion in teaming and in staff meetings.
