A Capital Projects Levy is commonly referred to as a ‘technology levy’ or ‘tech levy.’

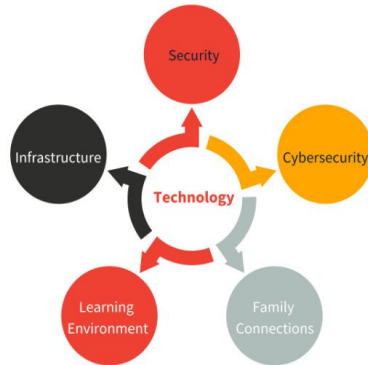

Community Thought Exchange

1. Instructional Technology:



Various benefits of students having access to devices = enhanced learning



Opps: Ensure there isn't reliance but yet integration of technology, consistent use of learning platforms and resource for family monitoring

2. Internet Safety



Noticeable support of safe online behavior



Opps: Provide additional resources on dangers and digital stewardship, consequences of inappropriate use and greater software safety controls

3. General School Safety:



Good physical security procedures, positive School Resource Officer partnership



Opps: Consistent safety procedures within the school and across the district, additional emergency preparedness efforts, streamlined communication procedures for serious incidents and greater bullying prevention support

4. School Communication



Inclusion of updates in and school use of Canvas and Infinite Campus



Opp: More consistent use of Canvas for general communication, greater transparency on student progress through platforms

5. School Environment



Educated and supportive staff, variety of enrichment opportunities



Opps :Consistent technology procedures in classrooms and use of family communication tools (IC, Canvas, Seesaw), technology integration with student behavior I(for families)

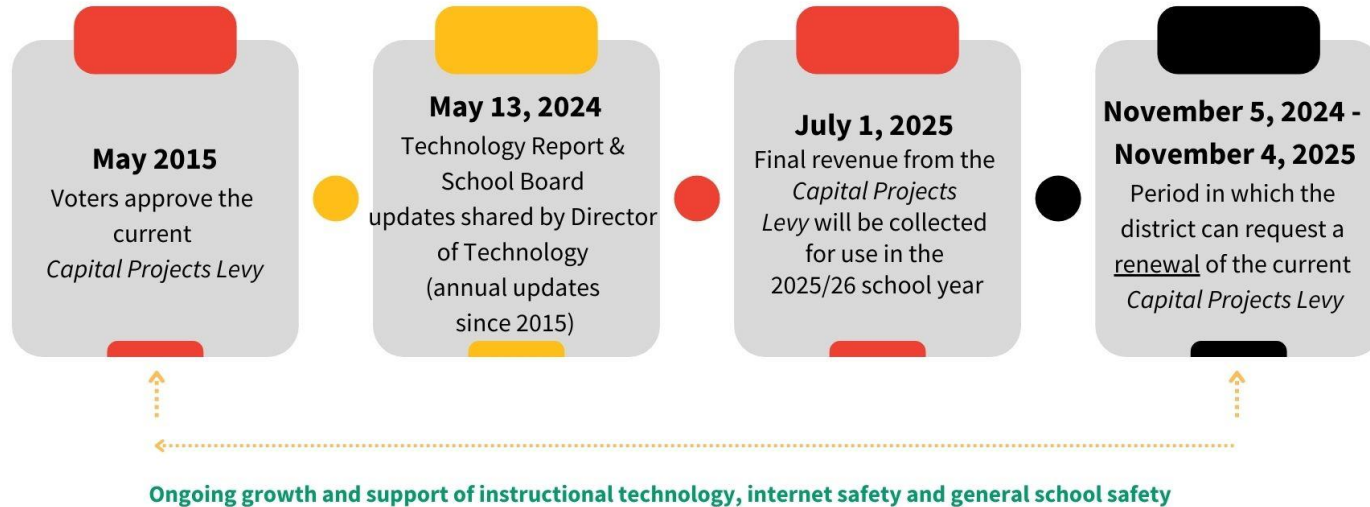
Capital Projects Levy– Background Information

- The voters in Shakopee **approved** the school district's current *Capital Projects Levy* on May 5, 2015.
- The final year of revenue from the current levy is collected in calendar year 2025 for use in the 2025-26 school year.
- A renewal of the current levy can be done at the earliest– November 2024, or the latest– November 2025.
- Director of Technology gave a 2024 Technology Update at the May 13, 2024 school board meeting.
- The 2024 Technology Update is a continue of previous Technology Reports
 - Tech Levy promises report card and other information

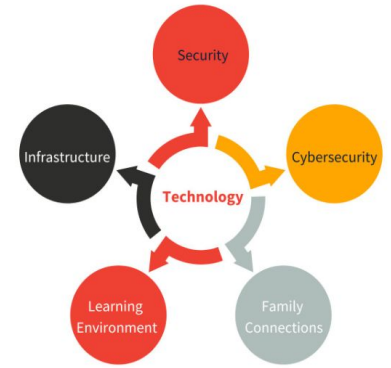

SAMPLE BALLOT LANGUAGE:

Renewal of Expiring Capital Project Levy Authorization

The board of independent School District No. 720 (Shakopee Public Schools), Minnesota has proposed to renew its capital project levy authorization expiring after taxes payable in 202X in the maximum amount of XX% times the net tax capacity of the school district to provide funds for the acquisition, installation, support and maintenance of software and technology and the acquisition, installation, support and maintenance of School District facilities, infrastructure, furnishings, and equipment. The proposed tax rate is not being increased from the previous year's rate. 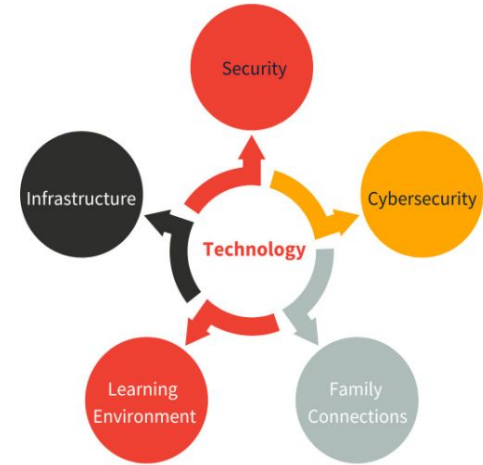

RENEWAL OF CAPITAL PROJECTS LEVY (TECH LEVY)

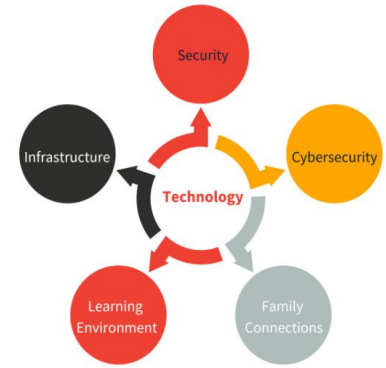
Projected \$6,215,800 in revenue in FY27

(2026-27 school year)

If levy is not successfully renewed, **budget impacts will be felt across the district** (i.e. need to pay for technology services, cybersecurity, video security, curriculum/software, etc. from other revenue sources).



RENEWAL



Per the current preliminary plan to propose a renewal at the present terms, the *Capital Projects Levy* would support the continuation of the district’s safety and critical support efforts in various areas of technology with no increase to taxpayers.

Capital Projects Levy– Planning & Communication

Planning in Motion

- Monthly **Capital Projects Levy Constructive Feedback** Committee meetings
 - First meeting held in April (2024), additional meetings held 1-2x a month (Committee approved by the School Board on April 22, 2024)
 - Includes consultative support from Finance & Operations, Communications and Instructional Technology Departments as well as Legal Counsel and PMA Securities.
- *Communications Plan and Election Timeline* (draft form)
 - Shorter in duration
 - Very focused messaging

Capital Projects Levy– School Board Actions

If November 5, 2024 is selected an election date, what does the School Board need to do to have the renewal included on the *General Election* ballot?

- Review Capital Project Levy final plan and details
- Pass a resolution at the June 24, 2024 regularly scheduled School Board Meeting
- Receive updates on an informative Communications Plan
 - Will include School Board *Community Forums* in the fall
